



Guadalupe County Texas A&M University Mothers' Club 2023 Scholarship Application



The Guadalupe County Texas A&M University Mothers' Club awards \$800 scholarships to graduating high school students who will attend Texas A&M University at College Station or Galveston as full time students. We will also award scholarships to currently enrolled, full-time, Texas A&M University (College Station or Galveston) students. These scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated excellent past performance in high school or at Texas A&M University and who exemplify the "spirit" of a true Aggie.

The following criteria have been established for the selection of recipients:

- Must be a graduating high school senior who will attend Texas A&M University in the fall as a full-time student or a currently enrolled Texas A&M University full-time student in good standing.
 - 12 hours with GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Student has not previously received scholarship assistance from this or any other TAMU Mothers' Club.
- Applicants must be graduating from or have graduated from a Guadalupe County high school and/or their permanent address must be in Guadalupe County or the following zip codes:
78121, 78132, 78152, 78266, 78638, and 78666
- Current high school students **MUST** be accepted to Texas A&M University by application deadline to apply for this scholarship.
- Blinn Team students are eligible to apply.
- Past applicants who have **not** received this scholarship are encouraged to reapply.

After meeting the above qualifications, return the completed application along with all attachments in the order listed below to the Guadalupe County A&M Mothers' Club (address below). **The application must be received on or before, February 1, 2023.** The deadline will not be extended and GC Mothers' Club will not be responsible for any late arrivals due to postal delivery.

- 2. Copy of letter (or other official verification) of acceptance to Texas A&M if high school or transfer student
- 3. **Official** high school or **official TAMU** transcript through the Fall 2022 semester with raised seal in a sealed envelope. **Photocopies unacceptable.**

Applications should be typed or neatly handwritten. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Please note:

If awarded a scholarship, students must present proof of fall enrollment at Texas A&M University on or before **August 15, 2023** in order to receive the scholarship. **There will be no exceptions.** Scholarship monies will be sent to the TAMU financial aid office after proof of enrollment has been received. The recipients of the awards will be selected and notified on or before March 15, 2023 and the scholarship recipients will be recognized during the Guadalupe County Aggie Mom's annual Howdy Dinner on **April 1, 2023**. 4. Attach a current resume. (Include a list of your work experience, activities, awards and achievements for the last four years.)
5. Essay:

Provide a well-developed, one-page essay answering the items below based on your application status:

- a. **High School Applicants** – Why is attending Texas A&M University important to you? Include in the final paragraph a brief statement of your future career goals and describe any financial need or circumstances.
- b. **Currently enrolled TAMU students** – What have you gained as a student at Texas A&M University, and what do you hope to gain in the future? Include in the final paragraph a brief statement of your future career goals and describe any financial need or circumstances.

6. Letter of Recommendation:

Recommendation should include some insight into the applicant's qualities and abilities that could include Integrity, attitude/motivation, dependability, initiative, ability to get along with others, leadership and character. It must state how long the person has known the applicant, their relationship, the person's printed name, title, signature and date.

7. Please include an 8x10 inch individual photo of yourself. These photos will be on display at the Howdy Dinner to honor all of our scholarship recipients.

Applicants are reminded that Aggies do not lie, cheat, or steal, nor do we tolerate among us those who do. Any falsification of information on this application is grounds for denial or termination of the scholarship.
